

Polylogarithms at non-positive (i.e. negative) multi-indices

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Abstract

We extend the definition and construct several bases for polylogarithms Li_T , where T are recognizable, by a finite state (multiplicity) automaton and of alphabet $X = \{x_0, x_1\}^1$. The kernel of the ‘‘polylogarithmic map’’ Li_\bullet is also characterized and provides a rewriting process which terminates to a normal form. We mostly concentrate on the algebraic aspects of this extension.
